



**ATTENDANCE AND VOTING AT THE GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE LEINSTER CRICKET UNION
CLG (FOR INFORMATION)**

Under the Company's Constitution as previously circulated the following are eligible to attend, speak and vote at General Meetings

1. The following shall be entitled to attend, speak and vote at this meeting:
 - (i) those person(s) nominated by each of those clubs that were accepted for affiliation at a General Meeting of the Unincorporated Association known as the Leinster Cricket Union and are thereby members of the Company. These clubs are set out at A on the list herewith and shall have a number of votes equal to the number of adult teams registered in league and cup cricket for the 2018 season. To exercise any right to multiple votes, there shall be a separate authorised representative nominated by the Club in attendance in respect of each such vote:
 - (ii) the person nominated by:
 - a. the Women's Section
 - b. the Youth & Schools Section
 - c. the Coaches Association
 - d. the Grounds Association
 - (iii) the President
 - (iv) the Immediate Past President
 - (v) the President Elect
 - (vi) the Chairperson
 - (vii) the Company Secretary
 - (viii) the Chair of Finance

2. Those eligible to attend, speak but are not entitled to vote are those Clubs located in the Province which have not yet been admitted as a member of the Company. These Clubs are Associate Members and are set out at B on the list herewith (over-page).
