



Code of Conduct for Youth Representative Players

A Cricket Leinster youth representative player will, without exception, and at all times, for the duration of coaching sessions, tours and tournaments:

- Respect and comply with all lawful decisions and directives of the Cricket Leinster Management Team.
- Respect and comply with the principles of the “Spirit of Cricket” as outlined in the Preamble to the Laws of Cricket.
- Conduct themselves in a manner as befits their status as ambassadors for Irish Cricket.
- Players under 18 years of age are prohibited from drinking alcohol. For players above 18 years of age, they may only drink alcohol with the express permission of the management team, and while in their presence.
- Respect and comply with the terms of the Cricket Ireland directive which bans, without reservation, the use of un-prescribed drugs and other controlled substances.
- Respect and comply with the laws and customs of the country in which the tour or tournament is taking place.
- Respect the property and belongings of others and maintain their accommodation, dressing room and practice facilities in a clean and tidy state.
- Respect and comply with the terms of the Dress Code as outlined in the letter informing player of Selection.
- Respect and comply with the terms of all curfews as outlined by the Team Management.
