Job Purpose/Responsibilities:

The responsibilities of the role include, but are not limited to –

- (a) Working with the Executive Committee of Clontarf to develop and implement a strategic blueprint for coaching for all teams across women's, men's and youth cricket;
- (b) Having full supervisory responsibility for all coaching in Clontarf
- (c) Deliver a coach education program to the other coaches at Clontarf to develop their skills and ensure the delivery of the best quality of coaching across all teams;
- (d) Working with the youth coaches to develop skills and session plans for youth cricket, including the local schools' program;
- (e) Oversee the delivery of youth coaching across all age groups including attending training sessions to monitor quality and consistency of coaching
- (f) Input into the development of "Friday Night Mini Cricket"; and
- (g) Coaching the Men's First XI, to include working with the Men's First XI captain to develop and implement training plans for pre-season and regular season training sessions.
